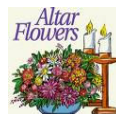

Counseling Services at Holy Family

If any one is in need of help there will be mental health therapists coming to the parish each week to provide services for anyone that might want to access this.

You can call 323-4406 and leave a message for Jentry Tillman and he will get back to you as soon as possible to make an appointment.

The services include family counseling, couples counseling, marriage prep, individual counseling for adults or children. The counselor will meet with you here at the parish office in private. It is totally confidential and provided on a sliding fee basis from \$80-\$5/hour, determined by your income.
