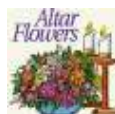

**Pastor's Rundown:**

On February 4, 1913 Rosa Parks was born. She was forty-two years old when she refused to give up her seat on a city bus in Montgomery, Alabama, to a white passenger, which at the time, the law required of African-Americans. She was arrested for her act of civil disobedience and worked with others from the NAACP to start the Montgomery Bus Boycott. The resulting integration of city buses in Montgomery ignited the civil rights movement in the United States and inspired nonviolent movements for social change around the world. Parks commented, "People say that I didn't give up my seat because I was tired, but that isn't true. No, the only tired I was, was tired of giving in." This is an important act for us to recall as we are each called to stand (or sit in this case) for what is really true and right. Jesus held his ground many times against those that wanted to kill the human spirit. Let us find the courage to seek reconciliation and renewal in our Christian lives as we continue to work for equality and justice for all people.

Lord, we have only to look at your life to know that reconciliation always costs something. Whether we are old or young, strong or weary, rich or poor, supply us with the conviction that reconciliation is always worth the price.

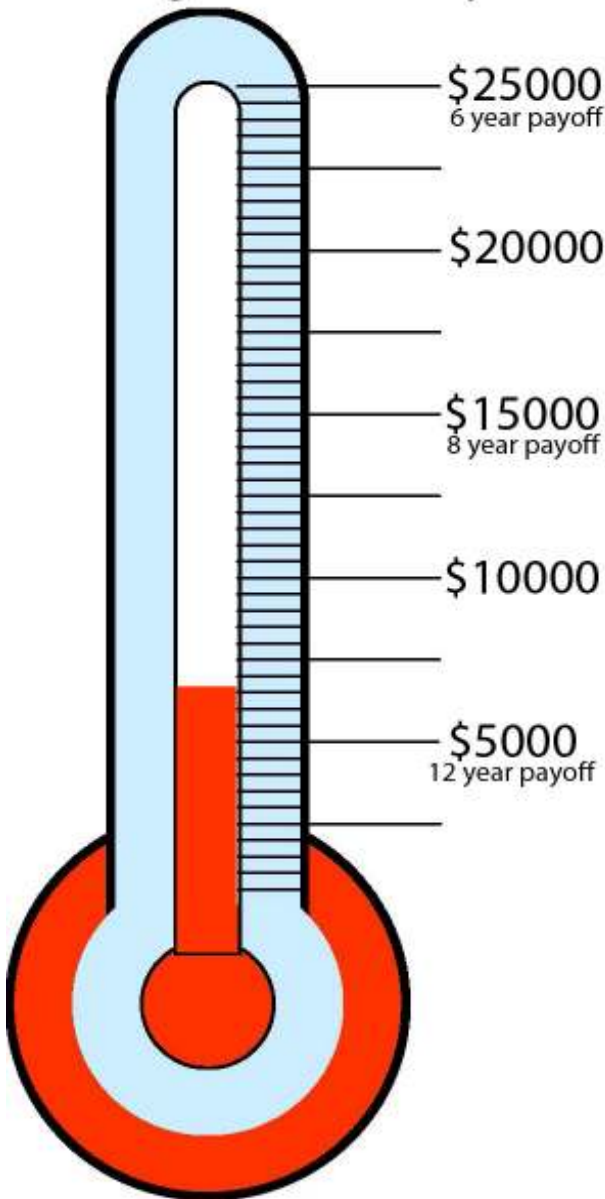
