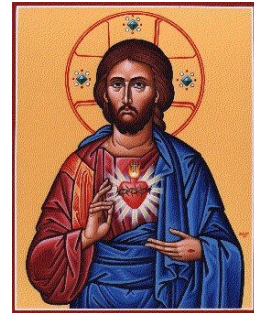

Gift Giving Opportunity



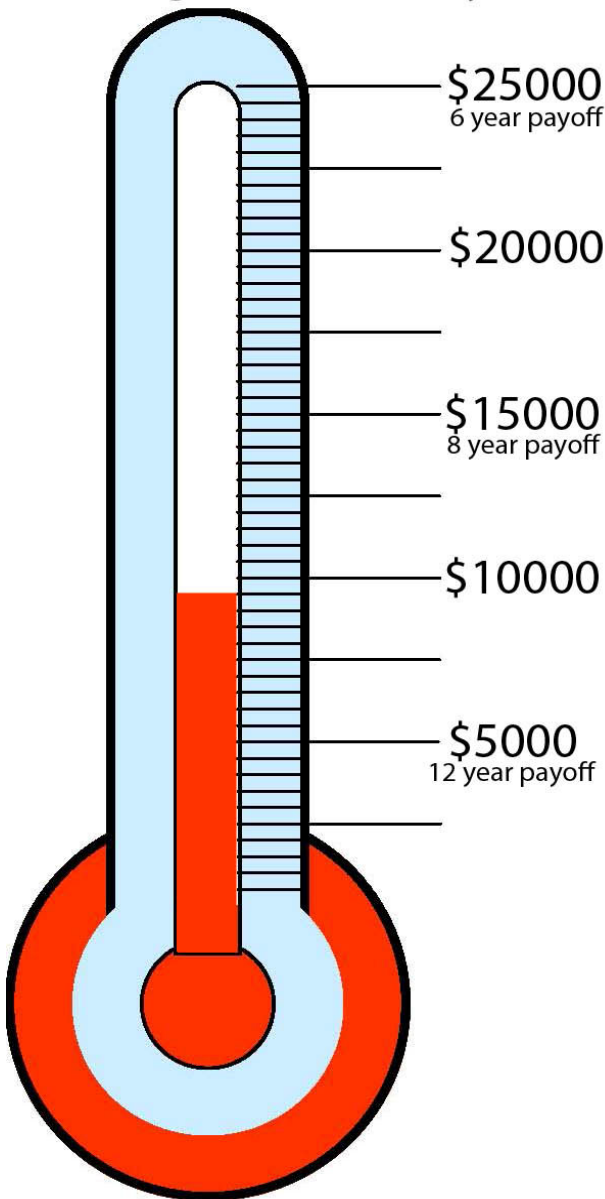
