**Gift Giving Opportunity**



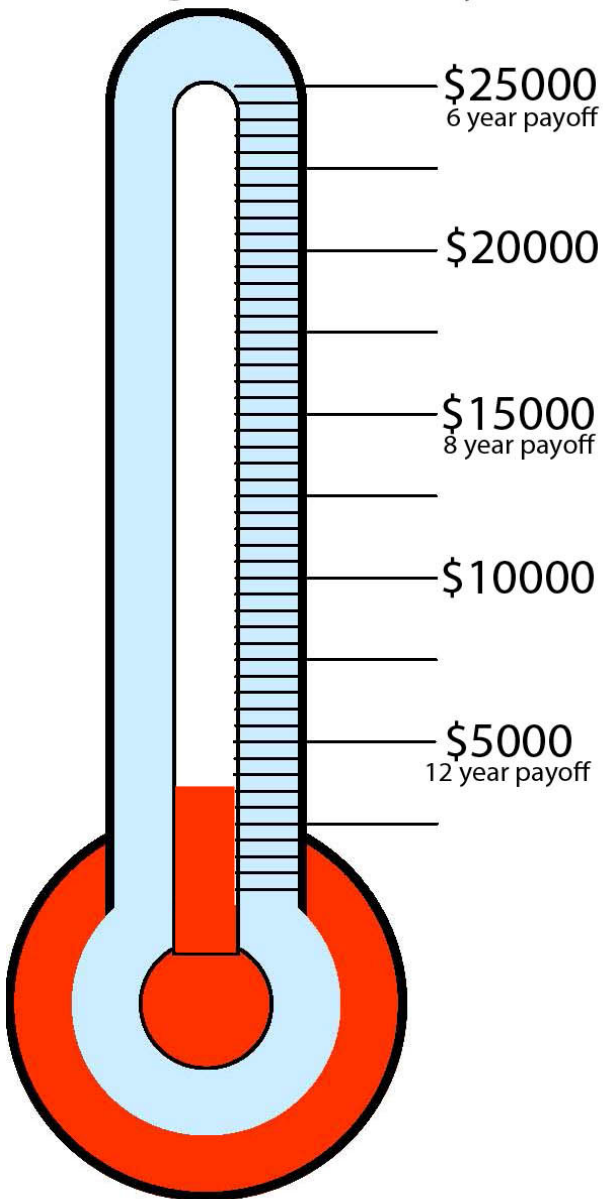
