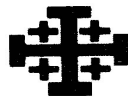

Pastor's Rundown:



During Lent I have been really thinking a lot about the guy that was on the cross next to Jesus, his name (tradition holds) was Dismas. Jesus knew the depth of his struggles and yet he still wanted him in Heaven with Him that very day! I bet that Dismas was wondering why Jesus would wish to be with him in eternity. Dismas probably thought "does he want me here because he wants to teach me? because he loves me? he wants to forgive me?" The answer was yes to all those questions. The invitation that Jesus extended to Dismas is the same invitation that the Lord sends to us each day! "I want you in my Kingdom today!!" So we are to be greatly aware of God's Kingdom around us on this earth! We must be open to the friendship that is offered us from the Lord each day. These aspects of God's invitation of love can be heard loud and clear if we open our hearts and minds especially during the Lenten season. For years there was a program that housed former criminal offenders named Dismas House. This program was quite a witness to God's forgiving love in the face of those willing to volunteer and even live at the house to care for the residents. This is a witness to our call to be healing and forgiving to others in our lives. We too can be the face of Christ to others who need to feel the acceptance and love of God through our actions. Again, Lent is a great time to try to act on that witness that Jesus gives us while on the cross. This season of Lent is a tough time for us as Christians, not only because we might be "giving something up" but mostly because we are to be aware of the painful sacrifice Christ offered and yet was still forgiving and loving in the middle of it and we are expected to follow that example!
