The Office of Tenebrae (which means "darkness" or "shadow") is a Holy Week devotion that dates back to the seventh or eighth century A.D. and is characterized by the successive extinguishing of the candles as the service progresses. *No service during the entire church year is more biblical; almost every word of the Tenebrae is taken verbatim from the Scriptures.*

Dr. Scott Hahn, Catholic theologian and Scripture Scholar will be speaking at Our Lady of Fatima Parish in Alcoa on July 16th from 11am - 4pm. Dr. Scott Hahn is an internationally renowned Catholic author and speaker. Dr. Hahn studied and was ordained a Protestant Minister in 1982. He was received into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil in 1986 and often tells of his conversion experience. Currently, Dr. Hahn is a professor of Theology and Scripture at the Franciscan University of Steubenville, Ohio. Over 500 of his presentations have been produced on audio and video tapes and he can be seen on various programs on EWTN Catholic television station. He and his wife, Kimberly, live in Steubenville and have six children.

(3) What's new or different about the revised translation?

The style of the translation of the third edition is different. In accord with the rules for translation established by the Holy See, the revised translation follows the style of the original Latin texts more closely, including concrete images, repetition, parallelisms, and rhythm. The English used in the Mass texts is more formal and dignified in style. Where possible, the texts follow the language of Scripture and include many poetic images.

In addition, the third edition contains prayers for the celebration of recently canonized saints, additional prefaces for the Eucharistic Prayers, additional Masses and prayers for various needs and intentions, and some updated and revised rubrics (or instructions) for the celebration of the Mass.

Lent is closely associated with the transition from winter to spring. "Lent" comes from the Anglo-Saxon word for springtime, *lencten*. This is the gradual *lengthening* of daylight after the winter solstice. Lent evolved around the theme of baptism which from the 3rd century had been associated with the vigil of the anniversary of the Lord's resurrection the Easter Vigil. In the first centuries preparation for baptism could last for several years. Adults who wished to join the church were tested for years. During this time they were instructed, supported then admitted to candidacy for baptism.

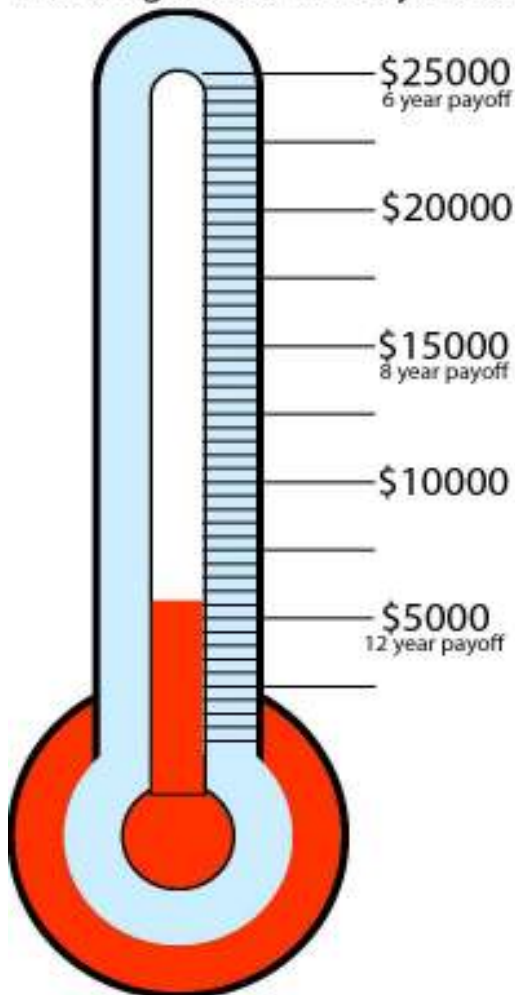
