Special Collection for Our Seminarians

Bishop Stika is asking Catholics across East Tennessee to generously support a special collection this Easter. Proceeds will offset the \$675,000 annual cost of educating 15 seminarians.

For those who set foot on the path toward priestly ordination – a journey that could take eight years of philosophical, theological and pastoral preparation – the cost is significant: \$45,000 a year. Believing that no one should be turned away from ministry due to an inability to pay, our diocese is committed to covering each seminarian's tuition, room, board, medical insurance and travel. During the current academic year, \$675,000 is needed. Due to a net increase of three seminarians next year, the diocese expects to spend over \$800,000.

Generous donors to the Catholic Foundation of East Tennessee contribute \$90,000 a year, covering the cost of preparing two seminarians. The education of a third seminarian is funded through contributions to the Annual Catholic Appeal. This leaves the diocese paying \$540,000 for the remaining 12 seminarians. Hopefully, a third of this amount will be contributed this Easter. Parishioners are asked to generously support the Easter collection for seminarian education.

(4) What is the timeline for the approval and implementation of the Missal?

After the Latin *Missale Romanum* was published in 2002, ICEL began its work of preparing a draft English translation of the text. ICEL presented the first section – the Order of the Mass, which contains the fixed prayers of the Mass, including the people's parts – to the English-speaking conferences of bishops in 2004. The USCCB approved the final version in 2006, and the Holy See confirmed this section in June 2008. The remaining sections were approved between 2007 and 2009. The USCCB completed its approval of the *Missal* in November 2009. The Holy See granted the final approval of the texts in the spring of 2010. Cardinal Francis George, OMI, president of the USCCB, announced that parishes may begin using the revised translation on November 27, 2011.

Holy week begins with Palm Sunday - called Passion Sunday these days because the theme of Jesus' suffering and death begins with the reading of the passion. On Palm Sunday the church celebrates the beginning of Jesus' passage from life to death to new life: the Paschal Mystery. Palms are blessed before mass and are carried to represent the footsteps of Jesus from the village of Bethany into the city of Jerusalem.

*The "palm branches" commonly used in the United States are "ground palm" from Texas.

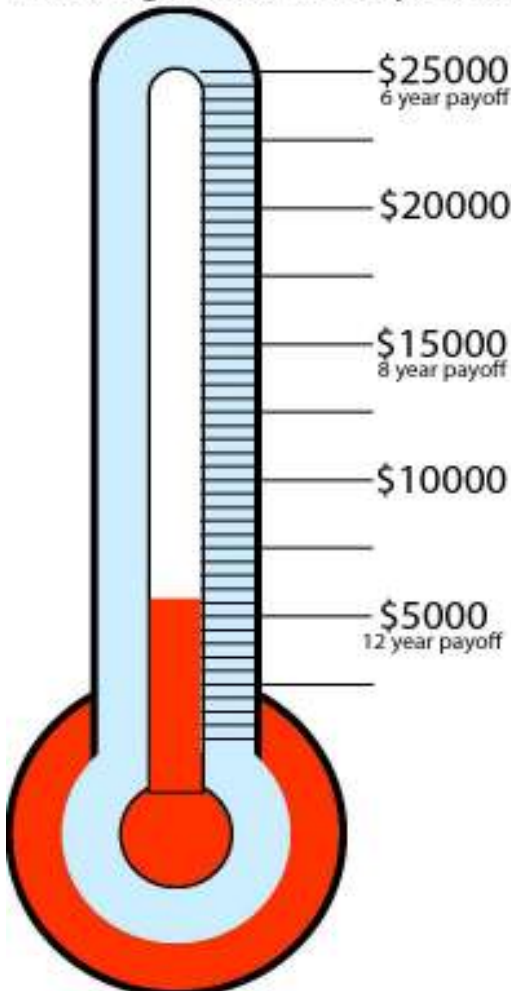
