The Church has now changed. The penitential atmosphere is lifted up to the joy of our risen Lord.

Newly blessed holy water is in place, the baptismal font once again is in view, the holy oils blessed at the Chrism mass have been placed in the Ambry.

The Paschal candle lit from the new fire was decorated at the Easter Vigil to stress ("Christ yesterday and today / the beginning and the end") And is decorated with a cross. The Greek signs *alpha* (the beginning) and *omega* (the end) are placed above and below the cross, the year is notated on the sides above and below the cross beam (All time belongs to him / and all the ages / to him be glory and power / through every age forever, Amen).

There are five grains of incense in the cross (By His holy / and glorious wounds / may Christ our Lord / guard us / and keep us. Amen). The color purple is now white and the Alleluia (Praise the Lord") acclamation returns to the liturgy.

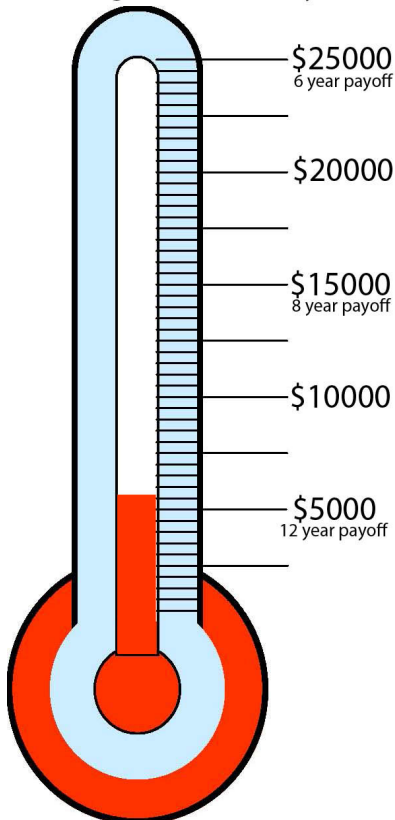
