Bishop Stika has asked that there be a **Special Second Collection** at all masses the weekend of **November 5 & 6** to help offset the cost of the **Diocesan Deacon Formation Program**. There are currently 28 men in formation for the Ordained Permanent Diaconate. These men come from 17 parishes across the diocese and they began their 4 ½ years of formation in September. Permanent Deacons offer so much to our diocese and parishes through their Ordained Service of Word, Altar and Charity. The average cost of formation paid by the diocese is nearly \$70,000.00 per year. Each of the men also pays a portion of the costs associated with the program. Please be generous in helping to fund this vocation to ordained ministry in the Church. Please pray for these men now and in the future as they begin their journey toward reception of the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

Pastor's Rundown:

It is quite obvious that as the Director of Catholic Charities and the Pastor of the best Parish in the universe, I spend time trying to help people share their money with these two awesome entities. So I rarely get caught up in trying to raise funds for other interests. It goes without saying that the Annual Catholic Appeal that the diocese does is essential (not only to support the infrastructure of the diocese but mainly because they give a significant grant to Catholic Charities of East Tennessee!). So we should all support that!

Last weekend and next weekend we are being asked to give some of our resources to two important ministries in our church, one international, the other local. First, last week we had the opportunity to give to the Mission Sunday appeal. There is an envelope for this in our boxes. This is key to the building up of the church throughout the world. I heard a beautiful story of a small church in South Africa being torn down due to issues of racism and discrimination. The Church building was able to be rebuilt by funding from this collection. So due to the generosity of folks that this community had never known, they were able to have a place to worship and build community and support.

The second worthy cause is the support of the Deacon program for our diocese. I have spent two weekends teaching a course on an introduction to the Scripture to a group of 28 men who are willing to give their time in service to building up the Church. There will be a second collection next weekend to help support this program. The great thing is that we have a candidate for the diaconate in our own parish, Gil Campos. So it would be nice to give to this collection so that we can support this ministry and to support our own parishioner in his pursuit of this vocation.

I know that no one wants to hear about money when they come to church but I really just wanted to highlight these important endeavors while also remembering how important our service to the poor and to our own awesome parish are when considering how to share our resources with others.

Angels cont...

3. Principalities

Depicted as carrying scepters with which they direct God's commands. With arch angels and angels they are the heavenly multitude that is God's ordinary and immediate service in what pertains to the visible word

4. Powers

Shown with swords, given their name because of their special power in restraining the assault of the evil spirit

5. Virtues

Charged with dispensing celestial miracles and accomplishing stupendous works

6. Dominations

Shown in royal robes and crowned for their authority; movers of stars and planets

7. Thrones

Shown in a kneeling posture of adoration; referred to also in Pslam 9:4 ...you have maintained my just cause; you have sat on the throne giving righteous judgment "

8. Cherubim (plural of cherub)

Angels of wisdom, guardians and protectors, stationed at Eden image erected in gold on the ark of the covenant

9. Seraphim (plural of seraph, "to burn")

Shown with six red wings and eyes; highest choir of angels named for the seraphim of Isaiah 6:2 distinguished by their burning zeal and love for the Trinity
