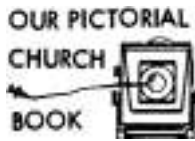

**Counseling Services at Holy Family**

If any one is in need of help there will be mental health therapists coming to the parish each week to provide services for anyone that might want to access this.

You can call 323-4406 and leave a message for Jentry Tillman and he will get back to you as soon as possible to make an appointment.

The services include family counseling, couples counseling, marriage prep, individual counseling for adults or children. The counselor will meet with you here at the parish office in private. It is totally confidential and provided on a sliding fee basis from \$80-\$5/hour, determined by your income.

**Pastor's Rundown:**

Last week in the Gospel passage Zacheus climbed a tree to be able to get a clear view of Jesus. He could never have seen the Lord if someone had not planted a sycamore seed, others watered it and nourished it and thus he had a method of seeing Christ in a new way! Here in Seymour, we have had a method of seeing Christ in a fresh way nurtured and grown. That is the folks who spent so much time and energy prepping and carrying out our mission! Thank you for letting us be "up in the tree" experiencing the risen Christ in a new way!

Now that I reflect on this reading some more, Jesus told Zacheus that he wanted to come to his "home".
