**Counseling Services at Holy Family**

If any one is in need of help there will be mental health therapists coming to the parish each week to provide services for anyone that might want to access this.

You can call 323-4406 and leave a message for Jentry Tillman and he will get back to you as soon as possible to make an appointment.

The services include family counseling, couples counseling, marriage prep, individual counseling for adults or children. The counselor will meet with you here at the parish office in private. It is totally confidential and provided on a sliding fee basis from \$80-\$5/hour, determined by your income.

**Deacon Dean's Food For Thought**

Last week we were so blessed with the mission of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Many of us have been re-enlightened with the knowledge of Jesus' great love for us. How do we share this love within are families (the Domestic Church) and our neighbors? One way we can get to know Jesus more intimately and integrate Him into our lives is through Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament! Adoring Jesus' presence in the Eucharist is God's gift to us. "It is from the Eucharist that all of us receive the grace and strength for daily living – to live real Christian lives, in the joy of knowing that God loves us, that Christ died for us, and that the Holy Spirit lives in us." (JP II)

"Our full participation to the Eucharist is the real source of the Christian spirit that we wish to see in our personal lives and all aspects of society. Whether we serve in politics, in the economic, cultural, social or scientific field – no matter what our occupation is – Eucharist is a challenge in our daily lives. Dear brother and sisters: there must always be consistency between what we believe and what we do. We cannot live on the glories of our past Christian history. Our union with Christ in the Eucharist must be expressed in the truth of our lives today – in our actions, in our behavior, in our life-style, and in our relationships with each others." (JP II) Let's set aside time every Friday evening from 6-9 pm to build this relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ in adoring him in his real presence, in the Eucharist.
